Overall job function: Under the supervision of the Clinical Manager (AGYW), the professional nurse with NIMART will provide comprehensive services to AGYW including ART initiation and sexual reproductive health services at safe space, and satellite service points as part of the in-school and out of school AGYW prevention program in the City of uMhlathuze.

Key duties and responsibilities

- Provide comprehensive primary health care services to AGYW at allocated service point including hand-off and transition care for AGYW between services within and across programs linked to the AGYW program.
- Routinely monitor performance & registers of program services
- Maintain adequate levels of consumables for the provision of comprehensive clinical services and provide HAST services including Prep on AGYW
- Participate in meetings and assist in the development of strategies for improved care
- Identify training needs for the mobile clinic team and arrange in-service training where needed
- Use relevant M&E tools to report to program M&E team on key indicators
- Form part of AGYW program sub-district team and provide monthly report to line manager

- Experience in program management i.e. development, work planning, implementation, monitoring, evaluation and reporting (MER); financial management and understanding and tracking of budgets
